

ABOUT

Main Remade is a Kentucky Transportation Cabinet project that will improve safety and accessibility along Main Street in downtown Louisville. The project spans from Wenzel Street to 22nd Street and will convert portions of the one-way road to two-way, making travel safer and simpler for everyone. Improvements will occur in three phases, starting with the East Phase.

EAST PHASE

Location: Main Street from Wenzel Street to 2nd Street, and Market Street from Brook Street to 2nd Street.

- O Includes one-way to two-way street conversions, adds protected bike lanes, and upgrades crosswalks and intersections
- O Construction will begin as early as late 2024
- O Main Street and Market Street will remain open during construction







IMPROVEMENTS

O Two-Way Conversions

- One-way streets prioritize speed for vehicles, while two-way streets reduce vehicle speeds, lessening the severity of crashes with other roadway users.
- Two-way streets also increase accessibility by offering more direct routes to destinations.

Crosswalks and Intersection Corners

The project will upgrade the marking and lighting of crosswalks, improving visibility and safety of pedestrians.

Protected Bike Lanes

A protected bike lane separated from driving lanes will be installed for bicycles and scooters. This will reduce the risk of crashes by limiting the locations where bicyclists and motorists interact.
